Pleasant Grove City recently adopted its budget for the 2015-2016 fiscal year.



A copy of this budget is available for review on the City's website at <http://www.pgcity.org/pleasant-grove-information-25006/city-budget>. By the first part of September, the City will publish a document that includes the City budget as well other financial information relative to the financial condition of the City. I encourage everyone to review this information in order to better understand the City's finances.

For the upcoming year, Pleasant Grove's General Fund budget is \$12,180,875. The General Fund is where City services not generally associated with user fees are accounted for. Services such as police, fire, parks, library, streets maintenance, and planning are all in the General Fund. The City also has other funds to account for other City services. Street surface treatments, recreation programs, and emergency dispatch are all accounted for in separate funds because they have a fee or tax specifically associated with them. Finally, the City has four utilities: water, sewer, storm drain, and solid waste. These activities are accounted for in enterprise funds due to the fact that user fees are intended to cover the full cost of these services.

I hope you choose to review our City budget. I know the budget can be complicated and maybe even confusing at first glance. Part of my job as the City Finance Director is to explain the budget to Pleasant Grove residents. Please call or come by City Hall to meet with me if you have any questions. I would be happy to discuss the budget or any questions you may have related to the City's finances.

In accordance with Utah Law, notice is given to all registered voters residing in the city limits of Pleasant Grove City that the Municipal Primary Election will be held on August 11, 2015. Polls will be open from 7:00 am to 8:00 pm. Requirements for voting: 1. Be a United States citizen; 2. Be a resident of Utah for at least 30 days immediately before the election; 3. Be at least 18 years old on the day of the election; 4. Be a registered voter; 5. Show a photo ID or two other forms of identification.
