Public Safety Building-What has changed since 2013?

Pleasant Grove City hired a consultant (MOCA Systems) to gather feedback from the public regarding the possibility of building a facility for police, fire and courts. Various committees were created and numerous meetings held to gather your feedback. Here's a breakdown of how much time was spent on this issue in the last four months:

- **12 Neighborhood Meetings**
- **10 Steering Committee Meetings**
- **6 Blue Ribbon Committee Meetings**
- **5 Citizen Committee Meetings**
- **1 Pleasant Grove Employees Meeting**




