## Water Conservation Plan

Enforced watering schedules will be:  
**Odd** number houses: Mon-Wed-Fri  
**Even** number houses: Tue-Thur-Sat  
*No watering allowed on Sunday.*

If schedules are violated:

**1<sup>st</sup> offense:** Warning- door hanger

**2<sup>nd</sup> offense:** Disconnection and  
\$50 reconnection fee

**3<sup>rd</sup> offense:** Disconnection and  
\$200 reconnection fee

*It is helpful to our system for some residents to water during the day.*

If we don't have some people watering during the day our system over-pressurizes and we end up sending water down the ditch.

*You may water anytime of the day.*

## New Secondary Water Rates

Last year Pleasant Grove City had a rate study done for all of its utilities. The City has implemented a four-year rate increase to get its utility funds solvent. As the City implemented these new rates, secondary water rates were postponed due to further study. **The City has adopted new rates that take effect on July 1, 2011.** The adopted rates also include increases for 2012 and 2013.


### Pressurized Irrigation Rates

	2012	2013	2014
<b>Residential Monthly Rates</b>			
Under .50 acre	20.85	24.50	27.75
.50 acre to .99 acre	24.96	29.37	33.65
1 acre and above	29.07	34.25	39.54

### **Commercial Monthly Rates**

For commercial parcels in excess of 1.5 irrigable acres - including schools, churches, and agricultural uses

Base Fee	29.07	34.25	39.54
Per Sq Ft ('000s)	0.2035	0.4070	0.6104
- Area over 1.5 acres			



These rates are different from what was originally proposed back in May. A look into the fixed costs of delivering the water led the City to design rates that were more fixed in nature. The lot size adjustment and appeal process are no longer part of these new rates. In order for a resident to qualify for the agricultural rate their property needs to be deemed "greenbelt" status by Utah County.

The City will also rent PG Irrigation water shares (or equivalent) by paying the yearly operating and maintenance cost. In turn, the City will be able to use your water in our secondary system.

Please be patient with us as we transition to these new rates. We understand some residents may have unique circumstance regarding secondary water. If you have any questions regarding these rates, please call us at (801) 785-5045.


