Resources - North Central Utah

### August:

21 minutes every 3 days

### September:

21 minutes every 6 days

***Please Note:*** Minutes shown are to spray heads, double time zones for rotor heads. Also, if you have poor draining soil type (like clay), water 3 separate times for 7 to 9 minutes.



## The City's 2010-11 Budget

### *A Challenging Year, City in a Great Position*

Pleasant Grove City recently adopted its budget for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2010. This has been a challenging budget to put together. Not only am I new to the City, but state and local governments throughout the country are experiencing difficult and challenging economic times. The slow economic condition has led to shrinking tax revenues. Meanwhile, the need for municipal services such as: police, fire, streets, parks, and recreation have not decreased. Pleasant Grove has experienced similar declines in tax revenues.

One thing that has helped the City get through these difficult times is during previous years, the City set aside funds in reserve. We have used some of this savings to help get us through these past two years. The currently adopted budget authorizes General Fund expenditures totaling \$14,012,741 and total City expenditures of \$27,767,511. During the upcoming year, the City is budgeting to draw \$542,941 from savings to balance the budget. As we look forward to future budget years, we will work together as elected officials and staff to fully align expenditures with revenues. I invite you to review the City's current budget, which is available at [www.plgrove.org](http://www.plgrove.org).

Despite difficult economic times, I believe that Pleasant Grove's future is bright. The City has tremendous potential for growth, and as the local, state and national economy rebound from the current recession, Pleasant Grove is in a great position to move forward.

# IMPORTANT!

## Pleasant Grove Water Conservation Plan

Due to the increased rate the water resources are being used in the Pleasant Grove Secondary System, the City is issuing a city wide conservation plan. We would ask all residents to follow these schedules in order to give us the ability to provide secondary water services for the remainder of the year. Without the conservation plan the City could run short in secondary water before the watering season is over. **These schedules will begin to be enforced Wednesday, August 4<sup>th</sup>.**

Here are the watering schedules:

**If your house number is an odd number: Your watering days are Monday, Wednesday, and Friday**

**If your house number is an even number: Your watering days are Tuesday, Thursday, and Saturday**

**No watering will be allowed on Sunday**

If residents violate these schedules:

**First offense: Warning via a door hanger**

**Second offense: Disconnection from the secondary water system and a \$50 reconnect fee**

**Third offense: Disconnection from the secondary water system and a \$200 reconnect fee**

Although general conservation plans don't recommend watering during the day, **it is helpful to our system for some residents to water during the day.** If we don't have some people watering during the day our system over-pressurizes and we end up sending water down the ditch. **Our water plan doesn't have any restrictions on the time of day you water.**
