Strawberry Days “Berried Treasure”





City Council Declaration of Candidacy

Filing period for the Pleasant Grove 2013

Municipal Election will be June 3, 2013-June 7, 2013.

Declarations must be filed with the City Recorder. *Mon thru Fri 8 to 5*. Declarations must be filed *in person*, or by petition if the candidate is not available to file in person.

Municipal Offices open for election this year:

- * Mayor – 4 year term
- * Two Council Members – 4 year term each



Qualifications to File for Candidacy:

- * Must be a United States citizen
- * Must be a registered voter of the municipality
- * Must be a resident of the municipality for a period of 12 consecutive months immediately preceding the date of the election
- * Any person convicted of a felony, any mentally incompetent person, or any person convicted of treason or a crime against the elective franchise may not hold office until the right to hold elective office is restored. Contact the City Recorder at (801)785-5045 for more information.

POLLING PLACES: State Law requires the City Recorder to designate the polling places to be used during a Municipal Election, and to obtain the City Council approval for the polling places. Normally we have had the polling places in the public schools and public buildings. This year we will be combining all the polling places into two locations. We have designated the **P. G. Community Center** and **Manila Elementary** as the Common Polling locations. Both locations will be open from 7am to 8pm on Election Day. Below you will find your precinct numbers and the location to vote. Both the Primary Election (if needed) and General Election will be held at these common polling locations.

P. G. Community Center, 547 South Locust.
Precincts: 02, 03 ,04 ,05, 06, 07, 08, 10, 12, 13.

Manila Elementary, 1726 North 600 West.
Precincts: 01, 09, 11, 14.
