PG Pool Improvements

Even though the pool has been closed since last September, that doesn't mean we have been letting it sit idle. Once we closed the doors we began work on several projects to improve the pool. We have added a new *Myrtha® Liner to the pool*. In addition to providing a nice padded floor for the "beach" area, the Myrtha® Liner will greatly extend the life of the pool. *Swimming pools that use the Myrtha® Technology have a virtually unlimited life*, thanks to the structural integrity and proven characteristics of the materials used and to the advanced techno-logical features of a modular system. In addition to the liner we are also working on *replacing the old carpet, updating some of the older elements of the pool and adding some new products to the concession offerings*. We are always looking for ways to improve our facilities and proud to be a part of the changes that are being made. Water Is On It's Way! With the weather warming, the secondary irrigation is now available. We encourage everyone to continue to monitor their use of our precious water resources. May is a great time to check your sprinkler system for leaks, over spray, broken nozzles, or misaligned sprinkler heads. Remember to check your sprinkler timer and program it properly for our water restrictions (only water certain days) and adjust for our cooler May weather.
