Administrative-Finance Division News

My name is **Denise Roy** and I am the **City's Finance Director**. I have been on board for approximately 9 months. Prior to joining Pleasant Grove City, I was Provo City's Budget Officer/Controller. My background includes 30 years of local government, with the past 15 years working directly in budget and accounting. I received my bachelor's degree in Accounting from the University of Utah.



As the finance director, my primary responsibilities are to prepare periodic reports on the City's financial and budget performance for the Municipal Council and citizens of Pleasant Grove; prepare the annual budget, and oversee the yearly audit and preparation of the Comprehensive Annual Financial Report.

When I was hired for the position, the City Administrator, Mayor and Municipal Council inquired about any experience that I had teaching a group of citizens about finance and budget-related issues. I'm excited to say that over the past few months, City Administrator, Scott Darrington and I have been putting together the new Pleasant Grove Finance Academy.

The **PG Finance Academy** will be comprised of three sessions lasting approximately 1.5-2 hours each. Our goal will be to help the citizens of Pleasant Grove understand the role finance plays in city government. **Enrollment is free and open to Pleasant Grove citizens 18 or older.** The academy will be on Wed evenings from 6 – 8 p.m. in the City Council Chambers located at 86 East 100 South on Aug 10, Aug 24, and Sept 7.

-Cost is \$50 per month, plus a \$50 registration fee.




