Recommended Use of Secondary Water



The City will start to pressurize the secondary water system about April 15th. Everyone is being asked to wait until **May 1st** to start watering. The following is the recommended watering procedure:

- Please check your valve to make sure that it has been turned off from the winter months.
- Open your valve slowly to check for leaks and broken pipes.
- If you have a broken pipe it was most likely frozen throughout the winter months.
- It helps watering during the day as well as at night in order for the system to operate more efficiently.
- It is recognized that watering during the day is less efficient, but it is necessary to better balance water use with supply.

Due to the ongoing drought we will continue this year with a watering schedule. If your house number is odd your watering days are Mon., Wed., and Fri. If your house number is even your watering days are Tues., Thurs., and Sat. We will be monitoring water usage for noncompliance to watering days and wasting water again this year. Compliance officers will be working around the clock. So please adhere to your days and conserve where you can.

CITY CLEAN UP DAYS: Pleasant Grove City Clean Up Days are Sat, **May 9th** through Sat, **May 16th**, from **8am-8pm** at the **OLD PIPE PLANT (400 N. 350 W.)**. This is for the Residents of Pleasant Grove City to help in disposing of their garbage from their yard and home. Please dump in the appropriate dumpster. There will be a P G City Employee to assist you as needed. **No hazardous materials, Paint, Tires, Cement, Televisions, Computers, Electronics or Chemicals will be accepted.** Green waste must be clean with no garbage mixed in with it. **There will be no dumping before or after hours.** We appreciate all the work you do to keep Pleasant Grove a beautiful community.

Pleasant Grove City 2015 Municipal Elections: Pleasant Grove City will hold a non-partisan Municipal General Election on Nov 3, 2015 to elect three Council Members to serve four-year terms of office. If more than twice the number to be elected file for candidacy, a Municipal Primary Election will be held on Aug 11, 2015. **The filing period for candidacy is June 1st-7th, Mon-Thurs 7:30 am-5:30 pm and Fri 8 am-5:00 pm.** (The candidate filing period begins the following Mon during regular business hours when June 1st is on a Sat or Sun). To qualify for candidacy, a person must be a United States citizen at time of filing, be a registered voter of the municipality, be a resident of the municipality or a resident of a recently-annexed area for a period of 365 consecutive days immediately preceding the date of election, and not be a convicted felon.
