

Water Conservation Plan

These schedules will begin to be enforced **Wed, June 15, 2011:**

Odd number houses: Mon-Wed-Fri

Even number houses: Tue-Thur-Sat

No watering allowed on Sunday.

If schedules are violated:

1st offense: Warning- door hanger

2nd offense: Disconnection and \$50 reconnection fee

3rd offense: Disconnection and \$200 reconnection fee

Although general conservation plans don't recommend watering during the day, *it is helpful to our system for some residents to water during the day.* If we don't have some people watering during the day our system over-pressurizes and we end up sending water down the ditch. *There are no restrictions on the time of day you may water.*

Mission of City Attorney's Office

It is the mission of the City Attorney's Office to provide information and accurate legal advice to the City, its elected and appointed officials, its various departments, and its boards and commissions. Additionally, it is the mission of this office to conduct prosecutions of violations of law in a thorough, efficacious, and equitable manner and to assist the authorized and assigned departments in the enforcement of laws and the protection of the health, safety, and welfare of the citizenry. The City Attorney's Office is committed to conduct our mission with integrity, holding itself to the highest professional standard.

The City Attorney is charged with protecting the interests of the citizens of Pleasant Grove in both civil and criminal matters.

The City Attorney's office consists of the City Attorney, one part-time prosecutor, and one part-time administrative assistant. Unfortunately, our criminal case load seems to increase each year. *The three most serious crimes that are prosecuted by the City Attorney are: Driving Under the Influence of Drugs or Alcohol, Domestic Violence, and Drugs - both illegal and prescription medication abuse.* In 2010 there were 125 cases of DUI; 170 drug related cases; and 347 domestic violence related cases; we also handled several thousand traffic cases.

Municipal Election & Candidate Information

A municipal election will be held this year for *three City Council seats* for four year terms. All members of the City Council serve at large, representing all Pleasant Grove residents.

Each person seeking to become a candidate must file a *Declaration of Candidacy* form in person with the City Recorder, or have a *Nominating Petition* filed in his/her behalf.

The filing period is July 1st-15th at the Pleasant Grove City Recorder's Office, 70 South 100 East (closed July 4th). A non-refundable fee of \$35 must be paid at the time of declaration. For information contact the City Recorder, 785-5045.

The qualifications to be a candidate are:

- United States citizen at time of filing.
- Registered voter of the municipality.
- Resident of the city or resident of a recently annexed area for 12 consecutive months immediately preceding date of the election.
- Not a convicted felon, unless the right to hold elective office has been restored.

If needed, Primary Election will be held on Tuesday, September 13th. General Election will be held on Tuesday, November 8th.
