Beautification news: Each year in April, Utah's City of Trees provides opportunities for tree huggers alike to celebrate **Arbor Day**. Originated in Nebraska City in 1872, Arbor Day started off with the planting of an estimated one million trees. A new, and uninvited guest, is seeking to make residency in Utah. The Emerald Ash Borer (EAB) is a very invasive pest that specializes on ash trees. Although not indigenous to the Utah location, the EAB is thought to have arrived in wood packing materials from its native home of Asia. Residents are advised to look for signs of the pernicious metallic green pest by signs of its destruction including: thinning of the tree's canopy, excessive growth at the base of the tree, bark splitting and woodpecker feeing.
