



Voter Registration

Information – 2013

Please be sure you are registered to vote! If you have changed your name or address, even within the City, it is necessary to re-register. The Primary Election (*if needed*) will be held on Tuesday, August 13, 2013. The General Election will be held on Tuesday, November 5, 2013. Pleasant Grove City will elect a mayor and two council members in this election.

The Utah County Clerk Elections Office is the responsible agency for registering voters in Utah County. Mail-in voter registration forms are available at the City Office or online at www.vote.utah.gov, where you are also able to submit an online registration. Voter registration deadlines are available on the same site or by calling the Pleasant Grove City office. If you're already registered to vote and would like the convenience of voting from home by mail, you may submit a Utah County Absentee Ballot Application, which is available on the above site or at the City office. The filing period for Declaration of Candidacy for the Pleasant Grove 2013 Municipal Election will be June 3, 2013 – June 7, 2013

Declarations must be filed with the City Recorder **Monday through Thursday 7:30 to 5:30 and Friday 8:00 to 5:00 during the filing period.** Declarations must be filed **IN PERSON**, or by petition if the candidate is not available to file in person.

Municipal Offices open for election this year:

- Mayor – 4 year term
- Two Council Members – 4 year term each

Qualifications to File for Candidacy:

- Must be a United States citizen
- Must be a registered voter of the municipality
- Must be a resident of the municipality for a period of 12 consecutive months immediately preceding the date of the election
- To not be a convicted felon, unless their right to hold elective office has been restored
