Events And Outdoor Opportunities

May is an exciting time for the Parks & Recreation Division. Baseball, softball & soccer are in full swing, the maintenance crews are ramping up for the busy spring and summer season and the outdoor opportunities are everywhere.

Valley Vista Trail Ribbon Cutting Ceremony will be held May 6, 2017 at 9:00 a.m. Join us for the official opening of the Valley Vista Trail System! Meet at the Valley Vista Trailhead, about 1/4 mile north of the Wade Springs parking lot (609 E. 1100N.) off the Murdock Canal Trail. **Parking is limited, so please bike to the event.**

Memorial Day will be celebrated on May 29th. The Cemetery will be staffed for those needing assistance Saturday through Monday. A quick reminder for **Memorial Day Decorations:** Cemetery staff will begin cleanup of decorations on **Tuesday, June 6**. Please remove items that you would like to keep on your loved ones headstone no later than **Monday, June 5**. Items left on the headstone or in the grass will be removed to ensure safety.

The Veterans Memorial Pool will open **Fri, May 26**. Please remind your children of the water safety rules. While most drownings happen in backyard pools, it's important to remember to always watch your children around bodies of water. After car accidents, drownings are the second largest cause of death in children under 5 yrs. Children under 9 yrs should have a responsible care giver in the water with them within a close distance. While floatation devices can be a great addition, they should not replace adequate adult supervision. **The Veterans Memorial Pool** offers swim lessons throughout the summer. There is also a swim team and water fitness classes available. See the pool front desk for information.

Discount season passes are available until May 25th.

A special thanks to the volunteers (coaches, service groups, scouts, boards, commissions and other volunteers) who help in so many ways to make Pleasant Grove a Great City. Please get out and enjoy the weather in one of the parks, fishing at the Manila Creek Park or take a hike on one of the trails.
