

Storm Water Pollution Prevention: Cleaner Street, Cleaner Water

The City's storm drainage system is designed to efficiently carry rain and snow melt to Utah Lake and away from our streets and homes. Storm drainage inlets are the grates or openings usually located in the street near the curb. **Storm drains are NOT connected to sewage treatment plants**, thus, all storm water, and the litter it carries from the streets, goes straight to our streams, creeks, rivers, and lakes.



Did you know?

Cigarette butts are not biodegradable. It can take over 15 years to break them down, all the while releasing the toxic chemicals contained in the filters into our waterways.

Liter adds bacteria and nutrients that hurt water quality, damages the environment, and creates unhealthy conditions for animals and humans.
