## **5. BUSINESS**

### **A. TO CONSIDER A RESOLUTION (2009-038) OF THE MAYOR AND MUNICIPAL COUNCIL SITTING AS THE BOARD OF CANVASSERS ACCEPTING ELECTION RETURNS AND DECLARING THE RESULTS OF THE VOTE FOR THE MUNICIPAL PRIMARY ELECTION HELD ON SEPTEMBER 15, 2009**

City Recorder Kresser stated that pursuant to Section 20A-4-301 of the Utah State Code, the Municipal Council and Mayor constitute the Board of Municipal Canvassers for Pleasant Grove City and do hereby canvass the returns of the September 15, 2009 Primary Election.

City Recorder Kresser passed out to each Council member present, the tally sheets from each of the precincts in order to have them certify the total votes cast. Each precinct list was received and verified by the City Council members and City Recorder Kresser, there were no discrepancies.

The next part of the canvass was counting the Provisional Ballots that need to be opened and added to the totals for each candidate. The totals from the Provisional Ballots added two (2) additional votes for Laurel Backman-Riddle, three (3) additional votes for Milton Fugal, one (1) additional vote for Lee G. Jensen, three (3) additional votes for John Morris, three (3) additional votes for Kimberly Robinson, and two (2) additional votes for Brent Skipper.

The total for the official count on the election returns is as follows:

The Board of Canvassers hereby certifies that candidates Kimberly Robinson, Lee G. Jensen, Laurel Backman-Riddle and Milton Fugal had the highest number of votes and declares them nominated to proceed to the General Election.

Mayor Pro Tem Call asked for a motion to approve Resolution 2009-038.

**ACTION:** Council Member Wilson moved to approve Resolution 2009-08 of the Mayor and Council sitting as the Board of Canvassers accepting Election returns and declaring and certifying the results of the vote for the Municipal Election held on September 15, 2009. Council

Member Atwood seconded and the motion passed unanimously with Council Members Atwood, Call and Wilson voting, "Aye."
