### **Pleasant Grove Police Honorary Colonels Donate K9 and Police Radios**

On Tuesday, September 9, 2014 the Pleasant Grove Police Honorary Colonels were honored by Mayor Mike Daniels and the City Council for their recent support for the Pleasant Grove Police Department. The Honorary Colonels worked with Havoc K9, a non-profit organization that trains Police K9 dogs, to provide a K9 dog to PG City for no charge. The new K9 was named Havoc (after Havoc K9), and will specialize in removing illegal drugs from our community. Mayor Mike Daniels, the City Council, and Chief Mike Smith thanked Havoc K9 and the Honorary Colonels for making the K9 possible. Also, Mayor Daniels and the Council thanked the Honorary Colonels for donating \$15,140 to purchase 14 portable radios and 1 car radio, enabling the PGPD to replace all of the discontinued radios from the 2002 Olympic donation with new digital radios. PGPD Chief Mike Smith said, "It is amazing that the Honorary Colonels have been able to partner with Havoc K9 to obtain a new K9 for Pleasant Grove. The radios the Honorary Colonels donated fulfilled a long standing need. The value of both donations is about \$25,000. Once again the Honorary Colonels have helped our community become safe."
