

Vote by Mail 2018

HOW DO I RETURN MY VOTED BALLOT?

You may return your voted ballot by mail. Postage is required. *Return your ballot early to ensure it is counted in the Election Night reports.* **BALLOTS MUST BE POSTMARKED ON OR BEFORE JUNE 25.**

Save a stamp and drop your ballot at one of our drop locations in most City Recorders Offices. Visit utahcounty.gov/elections for a complete list of locations.

WHAT IF I DID NOT RECEIVE A BALLOT?

If you did not receive your ballot in the mail, you will need to update your voter registration at vote.utah.gov

SOME VOTERS MAY NEED TO VOTE IN PERSON

If you did not receive a ballot or you need the amenities of the electronic voting equipment, you may vote in person during the Early Voting Period:

June 19, 20, 21 and 22. Or, on Election Day June 26 at any of our 24 Voter Service Centers. *Be sure to bring ID and proof of residency.*
